Trash Carts are Coming!!!

- Each resident will be issued a trash cart according to their current sanitation cost code.
 - 1) Those currently paying \$13.50 will be issued one 95-gallon trash cart.
 - 2) Those currently paying \$9.00 will be issued one 35-gallon trash cart.
 - 3) Residents who wish to use their own trash cart must contact the Sanitation Department at (740) 687-6660 and will be issued a sticker identifying the trash cart for pickup.
- All trash carts must remain at the address in which it is assigned. This means if a resident moves the trash cart must remain at the address in which it is assigned.
- Residents will be responsible for keeping their assigned trash cart clean. The Sanitation Department will be responsible for the repair and replacement of damaged trash carts.
- In order for your trash cart to be serviced the following guidelines must be met:
 - 1) Place as much trash that will fit in trash cart, with the lid completely closed.
 - 2) Trash carts must be placed within 3 feet of the street edge or alley with lid opening facing the street and the wheels toward the residence.
 - 3) Trash carts must be placed at least 3 feet from any tree, pole, mailbox, etc. and at least 10 feet from parked cars.
 - 4) Additional trash cannot be stacked on top of the trash cart.
 - 5) Multiple trash carts must be spaced 3 feet apart.
 - 6) Trash carts must be set out at the street edge or alley by 7:30am on your scheduled pickup day.
- Yard Waste Guidelines:
 - 1) Yard waste must be tied in bundles not exceeding four feet in length and two feet in diameter and weighing no more than fifty pounds each.
 - 2) Or placed in bio-degradable paper bags weighing no more than fifty pounds each when loaded with yard waste.
 - 3) Co-mingling yard waste with trash within the same container is PROHIBITED.
 - 4) **ALL** yard waste must be set out at the curb in front of the residence.

If you have old trash cans that you wish to dispose of you may set them out on your scheduled pick up day with a note attached reading "Take Can" or you may contact the Sanitation Department at (740) 687-6660.
